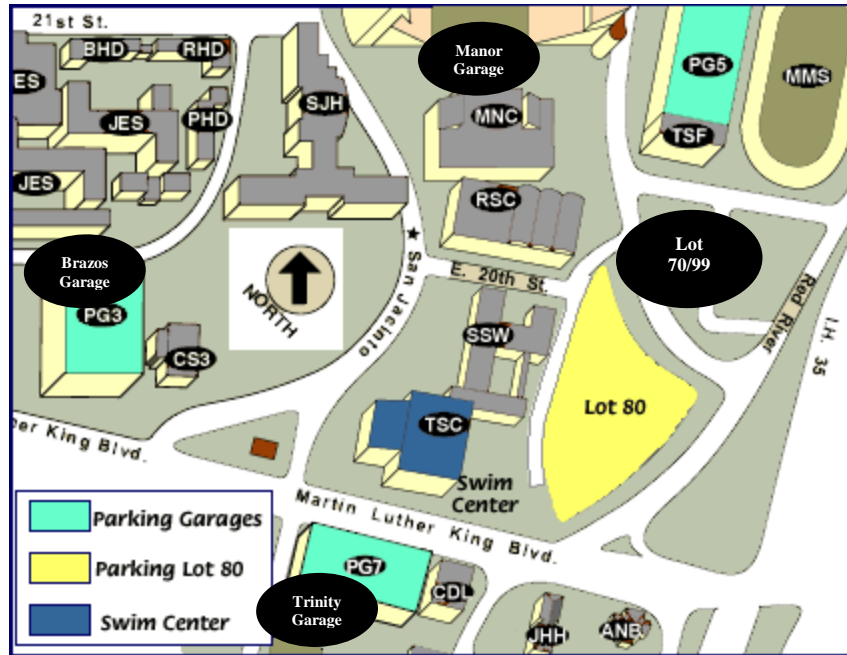


2010 Texas Open Parking



Parking Options for Texas Open **PLEASE READ**

The University of Texas now requires that you have a UT permit AT ALL TIMES to park in any lot (including C lot 80 in front of the Swim Center) or along San Jacinto behind the Swim Center. Only park in C lot 80 if you have a UT permit OR if there is an attendant and you can pay to park – you must display your receipt to avoid a ticket. Here are your options:

1. Park in the **Trinity Garage**: Park in Trinity Garage for pre-pay parking at \$10 per entry or purchase a **multi-day event card available for use on July 2-4. The rate for the multi-day card will be \$30 for Friday through Sunday. The card allows in and out access. The multi-day card will be available for purchase on the second level of the Texas Swimming Center (TSC). Drive into the Trinity Garage, pull a ticket, and purchase your event card at the TSC. The event card will only be available for purchase on Friday, July 2, from 1:30-5 pm. The garages will be charging on July 4.**
 - **The event swipe cards must always be used in the RED machines!!** The yellow machines will not return the swipe card to you.
 - Upon entering the garage, use the swipe card in the **RED machine** to gain access to the garage. **If you use the swipe card, do not pull a ticket.** If you use your swipe card to enter the garage, **you must use your swipe card to exit**, even if the garage gates happen to be open. If you do not swipe, the card will not work when you try to enter the next time. The machine will think you are still in the garage.
 - Remember this allows you to come and go as many times as you wish. If you are only coming to one session a day, you may not need the swipe card. **If you decide you do not want to purchase the event swipe card, parking will cost \$10 with no in/out privileges. You may park in any of the garages.**

2. Park in one of the **State Garages** after 6 PM Friday (not an open lot) at the intersection of 17th St. and San Jacinto St. just south of the Swim Center. As of 6/28/10 the State Garages **may** not be charging July 3-4 and will be available for free parking.

Vehicles parked in restricted areas without a permit will receive a citation.

Please be sure to read the signs carefully.
